II. NEW BUSINESS

A. Presentation from Bob Cohen with commZoom (Bob Cohen, commZoom) *Bob Cohen stood at the podium and gave the Mayor and Council an extensive presentation on his company commZoom. CommZoom is an internet provider, that is currently in the Poteet, Pleasanton, Jourdanon area installing internet lines. Mr. Cohen explained that this company is looking for the City of Poteet's business. City Administrator Eric Jiminez explained that currently Poteet uses GVEC for internet services. The City doesn't pay for internet services provided by GVEC, because of an agreement allowing them to place their antennas on our water towers. However, he explained that the service is no good. Mr. Jiminez explained that the internet is consistently going down. ComZoom allegedly has much better coverage with less breaks in service. This was a presentation on, no action taken.*

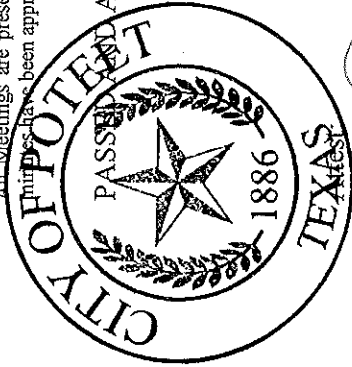
