The Strawberry Festival Grounds will be open at 6am on the day of the event (**November 3, 2018**). Registration table will be open at 6:30am for day of registration, t-shirt & bag pick up. All attendees and participants will enter through main gate to the festival ground off of State Hwy 16 in the City of Poteet. A large runners pavilion will be next to the start / finish line across from parking area. The runner pavilion will have food / drink and activities for runners.

5K – Course will take runners off the festival grounds and into the country side then return them to grounds and finish where they started. The route is predominately level course on a few types of paved services. **START TIME 8:00AM**

10K – Course will take runners off the festival grounds and into the country side surrounding the City of Poteet. The route is level with a few slight hills, the most aggressive as runners turn South on Hwy 16 from McCaughan Rd and head back to festival ground finish line. **START TIME 7:45AM**
