

ORDINANCE NO. 06042019-03

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POTEET, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 07032018-01, SECTION 7, IX(B) DISCONNECTION FEE, OF THE CITY'S UTILITY SERVICE ORDINANCE; INCORPORATING RECITALS; PROVIDING REPEALING, SAVINGS, AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the current fee set for water disconnection has been reviewed by the City Council and the fees for customers are in need of adjustment; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance only reflects the revised fee to be charged for water disconnection; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2019 the City Council voted to amend and adopt the utility disconnection fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POTEET, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. That the Utility Service Ordinance of the City of Poteet, Texas Section 7 - "Utility Bill Procedures; Adjustments in Utility Billing; Water/Sewer Bill Late Fee Charges; Termination/Disconnection of Services", specifically section IX – "Water/Sewer Bill Fee Changes", specifically subsection (b) – "Disconnection Fee", is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) Disconnection Fee. If payments are not made by 4:30 p.m. on the Friday preceding the fourth (4th) Monday of each month, or received in the night drop-box before the open of business on the fourth (4th) Monday of each month, or a final payment is posted before noon on the fourth (4th) Monday of each month, then a Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) disconnect fee for non-payment will be applied to the bill.

SECTION 2. All provisions not amended herein shall remain unchanged.


SECTION 3. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City Council.


SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

SECTION 5. It is officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
